In modern Iran, Shiraz wine cannot be produced legally due to the prohibition of alcohol in Islam. Before the Islamic Revolution in 1979, there were up to 300 wineries in Iran; now there are none. As a whole, Iran is not a wine-producing country anymore, but Iranian Christians are legally allowed to ferment wine, and the rules of prohibition are widely ignored.

WHITE

SIBILIANO GRILLO/ITALY

A completely fresh, organic and moreish wine with hints of ripe stone fruits with clear, apple-like acidity. A softer style of unoaked white wine.

SOLDIERS BLOCK SHIRAZ/AUSTRALIA

A medium to full bodied Victorian Shiraz, dangerously moreish by the glass. Bright, aromatic and juicy on the nose with just a touch of crushed cranberry and blackcurrant with a good dash of spice.

SOTTANO MALBEC/ARGENTINA

A full bodied yet super-velvety Malbec full of scents of red and ripe fruits such as cherries and plums. Aged in French & American oak which impart delicate chocolate and vanilla flavours too. Sublime.

DOMAINE DE TOURELLES/LEBANON
